SUNDAY JANUARY 6, 2019

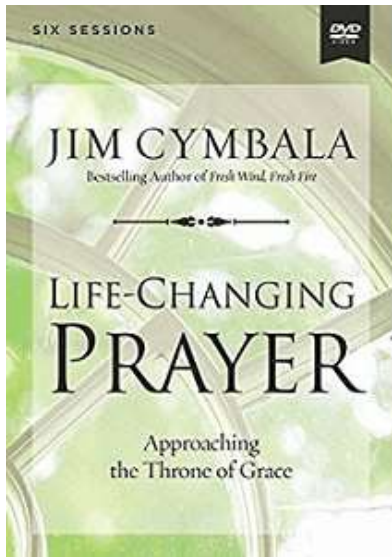
Pastor will be ministering this morning and Brother Herby Pruitt will minister in the PM service.

BIBLE TRIVIA— DAMASCUS

1. What message did king Ahaz send to Urijah the priest when he visited the king of Assyria in Damascus?
2. This king "sacrificed unto the gods of Damascus, which smote him: and he said, Because the gods of the kings of Syria help them, therefore will I sacrifice to them, that they may help me. But they were the ruin of him, and of all Israel." Who was he?
3. Two prophets prophesied that God would "kindle a fire in the wall of Damascus, and it shall consume the palaces of Benhadad." Who were they?
4. From whom did Saul seek letters before he went to Damascus to persecute the disciples of the Lord?
5. Paul stood before this man and testified, "Whereupon, I was not disobedient unto the heavenly vision: But showed first unto them of Damascus, and at Jerusalem, and throughout all the coasts of Judaea, and then to the Gentiles, that they should repent and turn to God, and do works meet for repentance. For these causes the Jews caught me in the temple, and went about to kill me..."
