The Willing Hands Crochet class will meet this Tuesday Sept. 10th at 6PM.


This Wednesday September 11th at 7PM we will be having a bible study. Pastor will be teaching.

2. This man was the second judge of Israel. He thrust a dagger into the king of Moab so hard that the handle went into him as well!
3. This lady was a judge of Israel - she told Barak, "The road you take will not lead to your glory, for the Lord will sell Sisera into the hand of a woman."
4. This judge of Israel had his army dramatically reduced right down to 300 men, but the Lord still gave him victory.
5. This man was made a king of Israel - he was killed by a woman who threw an upper millstone off the tower at Thebez.
6. After the man in question five, Tola, a man of Issachar, was a judge. What does the book of 1 Chronicles tell us about the men of Issachar?
7. Jephthah was a mighty warrior. He made a vow to the LORD, and said, "If you will give the Ammonites into my hand, then whoever comes out of the doors of my house to meet me, when I return victorious from the Ammonites, shall be the Lord's, to be offered up by me as a burnt offering."
